Frank Girman, age 97, of Brunswick, Ohio, passed away on May 8, 2020. He was born March 12, 1923 in Wyandotte, Michigan to the late John and Anna (Ferencz) Girman. Frank was employed as an electrician for the City of Cleveland until his retirement in 1977.
